

FAQs for Good Counsel Boys' Basketball Camp

1. Are there group discounts?

There are group discounts for groups of 5 to 9 (\$10 per camper) and groups of 10 or more (\$15 per camper). In order to receive a group discount all of the registration forms and payments must be mailed together.

2. Are there family discounts?

There are no discounts for families unless there are 5 or more.

3. Is there an early registration discount?

Yes, early registration ends April 15th at the cost of \$225 per camper per session.

4. Is lunch available for purchase?

Yes, we have a snack bar that is open from 8:30 to 3:30 and we have lunch specials available each day ranging from hot dogs and pizza to nachos and chicken nuggets.

5. Are there activities that occur outdoors?

Yes, we have two indoor gyms, both air conditioned, and we have portable baskets that we use outside in the parking lot for stations, practices and occasional games. We also use the outdoor courts at the Kim House next door to Good Counsel for games and stations for the older campers only.

6. What do you do on code red air quality days with outdoor activities?

On code red days we do not allow for any outdoor activities past the lunch.

7. Is there a camp bank for my son to keep his money?

We have a camp bank where the campers can make a deposit at any point in the week and then make purchases with that money for the duration of the week.

8. How are the campers separated in leagues and on teams?

The campers are separated initially by age on the registration form into a league. Once they are in a league we then separate the campers onto teams. The first two games of the day then are used to even out the teams so that we have as even teams for the week and all campers get to experience wins and losses.

9. Can I request my son to be with his friend?

Rarely do we allow for special requests due to the size of the camp and the belief that we have that it is of great benefit for kids to use basketball to meet new people and play with kids who they do not know. In the past we honored these requests and the kids who made the request

only passed to each other. This is counterproductive to the philosophy of the camp. Special requests, however, are honored when a camper is coming from out of town and staying with another camper.

10. When can I drop off my son?

Even though we do not have before care, we do have an adult presence in the gym at 8:00 for early drop off.

11. When can I pick my son up?

Pick up is at 3:00 each day. At that time you may come in and get your son or you may stay in line in your car and we will bring the kids out to the curb. If you need to pick up your son later than that, then you can pay for after care which runs from 3:00 to 5:00 each day.

12. Can I come to camp early and watch my son play?

Any relative can come and watch their son at any point during the day.

13. How is the day broken up?

The general schedule for each day is as follows:

14. Is there a different schedule for Friday?

Yes, there is a different schedule for Friday. It generally goes as follows:
